Covid Mitigation Thresholds

- If any two of the thresholds below are met, office staff will automatically communicate the change in procedures.
- If any one of the thresholds below is met, the Task Force (meeting twice monthly) will submit its recommendation for change in procedures.
- Mitigation Procedures are as follows:
 - o 1st level mitigation (at all times): Unvaccinated individuals over age 3¹ are asked to wear masks while on campus, and must wear masks if participating in any ministry with others. Vaccinated individuals may be asked to wear masks if working or participating with unvaccinated children or youth, per ministry leader(s). Social distancing is encouraged indoors.
 - 2nd level mitigation: All individuals on campus over age 3 are required to wear masks. All individuals on campus should maintain a social distance of six feet or greater, except where impractical (e.g. preschool class management).
 - o 3rd level mitigation: Previous mitigation is followed, with the following additions: Children's and Youth ministries halt in-person gatherings, worship shifts to online only, and no groups of greater than 12 shall be allowed on campus.
 - o 4th level mitigation: The campus is closed.
